

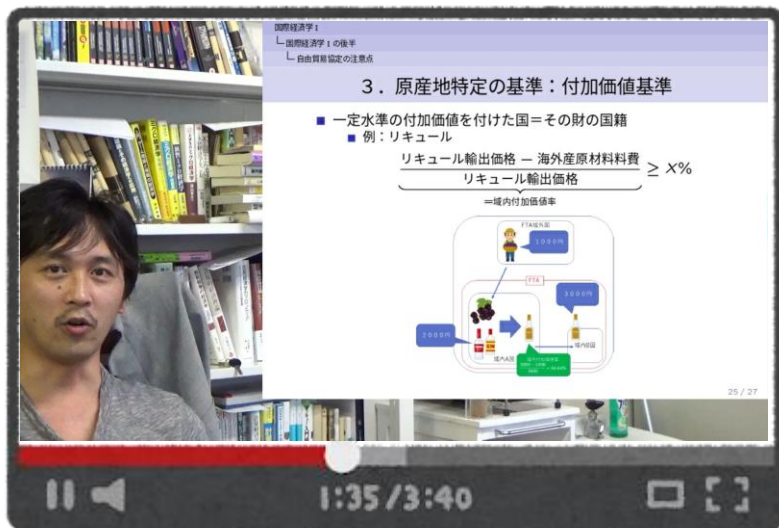

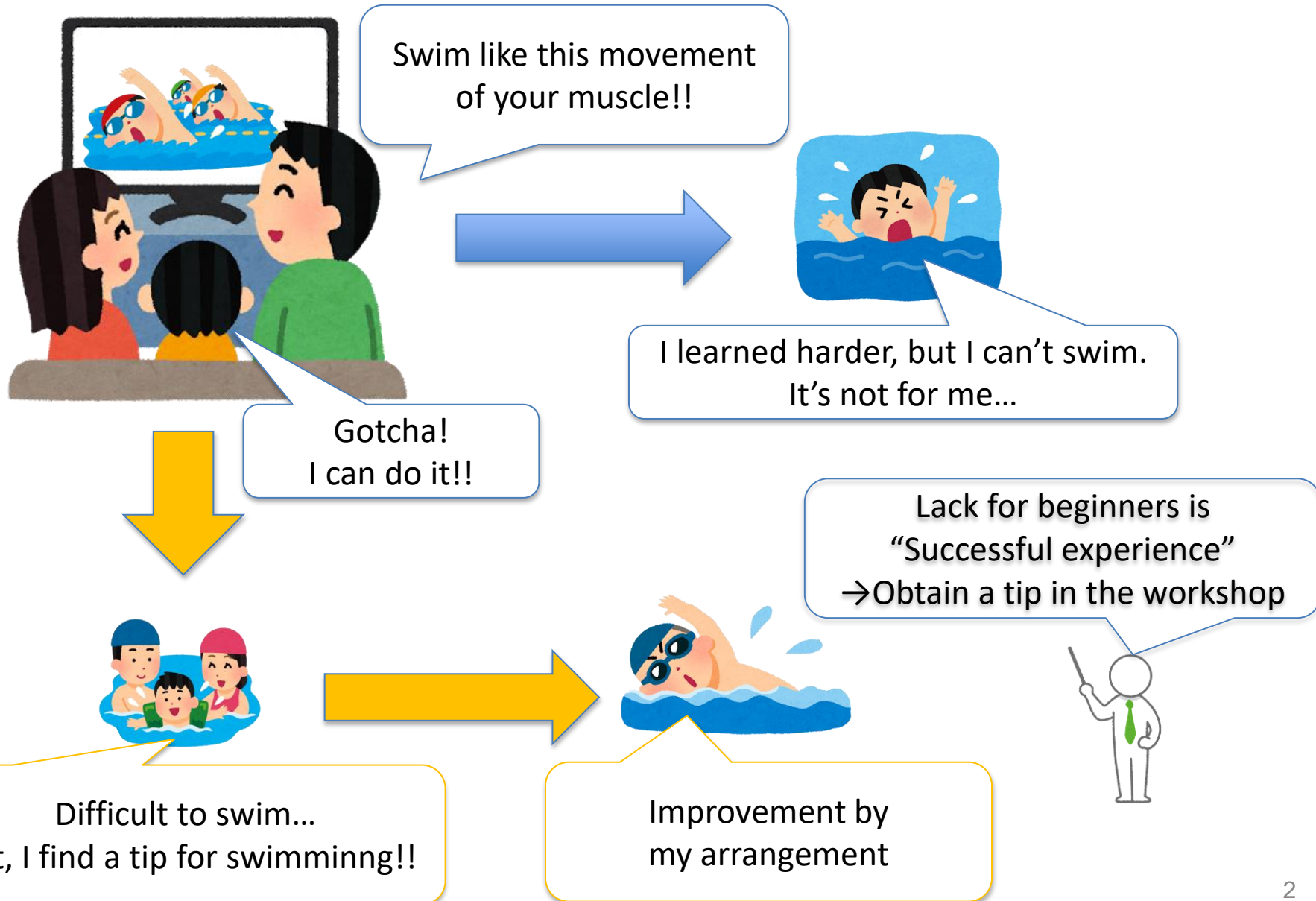





- What you need!!
 - Original lecture video to edit
 - With Record function of Zoom and/or PPT, Video camera, ... etc
 - Video Editor App: “Filmora X”
 - <https://filmora.wondershare.com/>
 - Perpetual plan: 8480 Yen
 - Trial version is freely available (w/ Watermark)
 - Need to create ID to export your video
- Recommended environment for the workshop
 - PC w/ “Filmora X”
 - Edit a video with my instruction on Teams’ screen!!
 1. 2 displays
 - One display for Teams & Another for your “Filmora X”
 2. 2 PCs
 - One PC for Teams & Another for your “Filmora X”

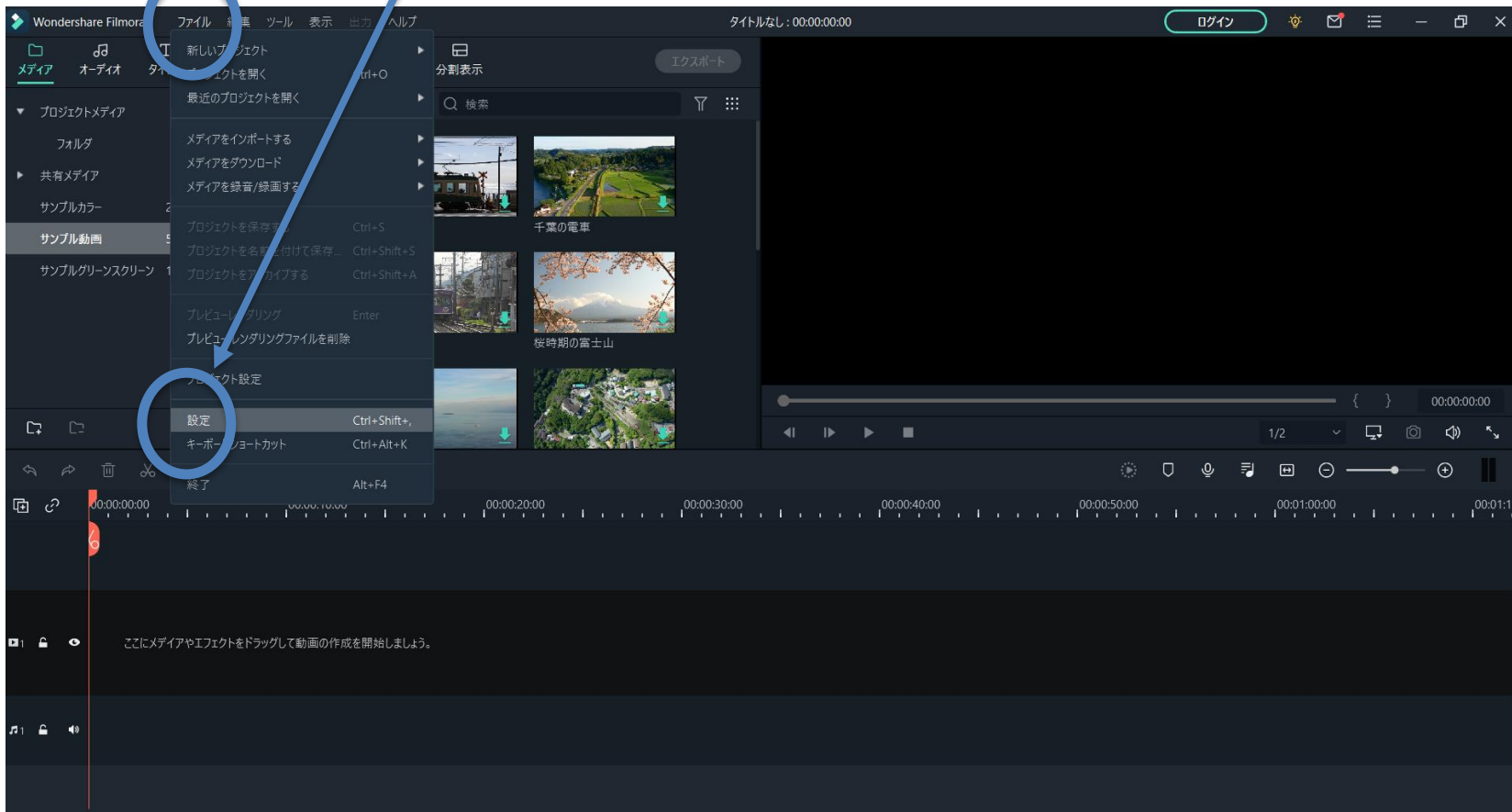

Start “Filmora X” w/ Language setting

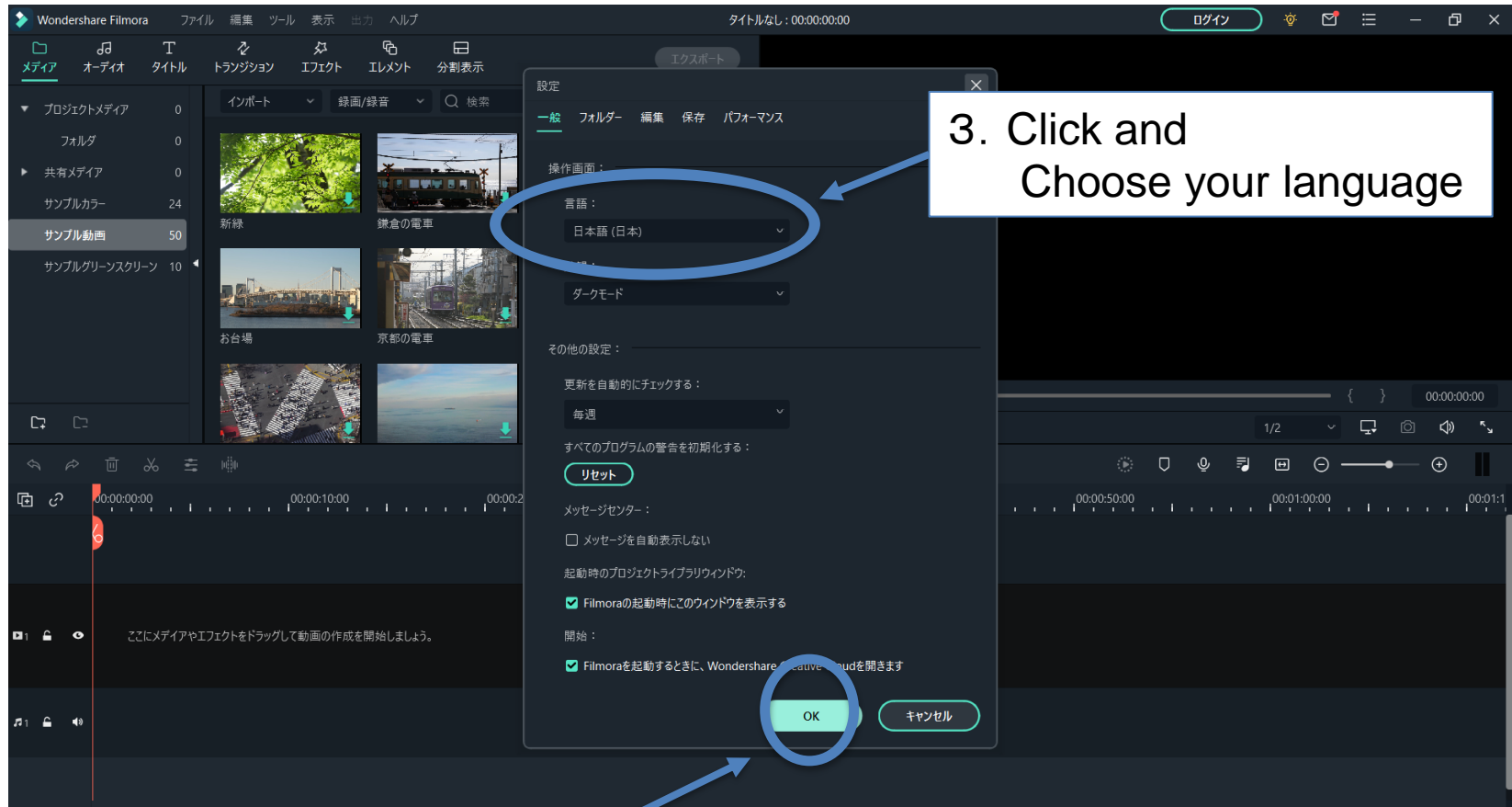


1. Launch the app → 「New Project」
→ Following edit-screen appears

2. Click 「File」 → Click setting

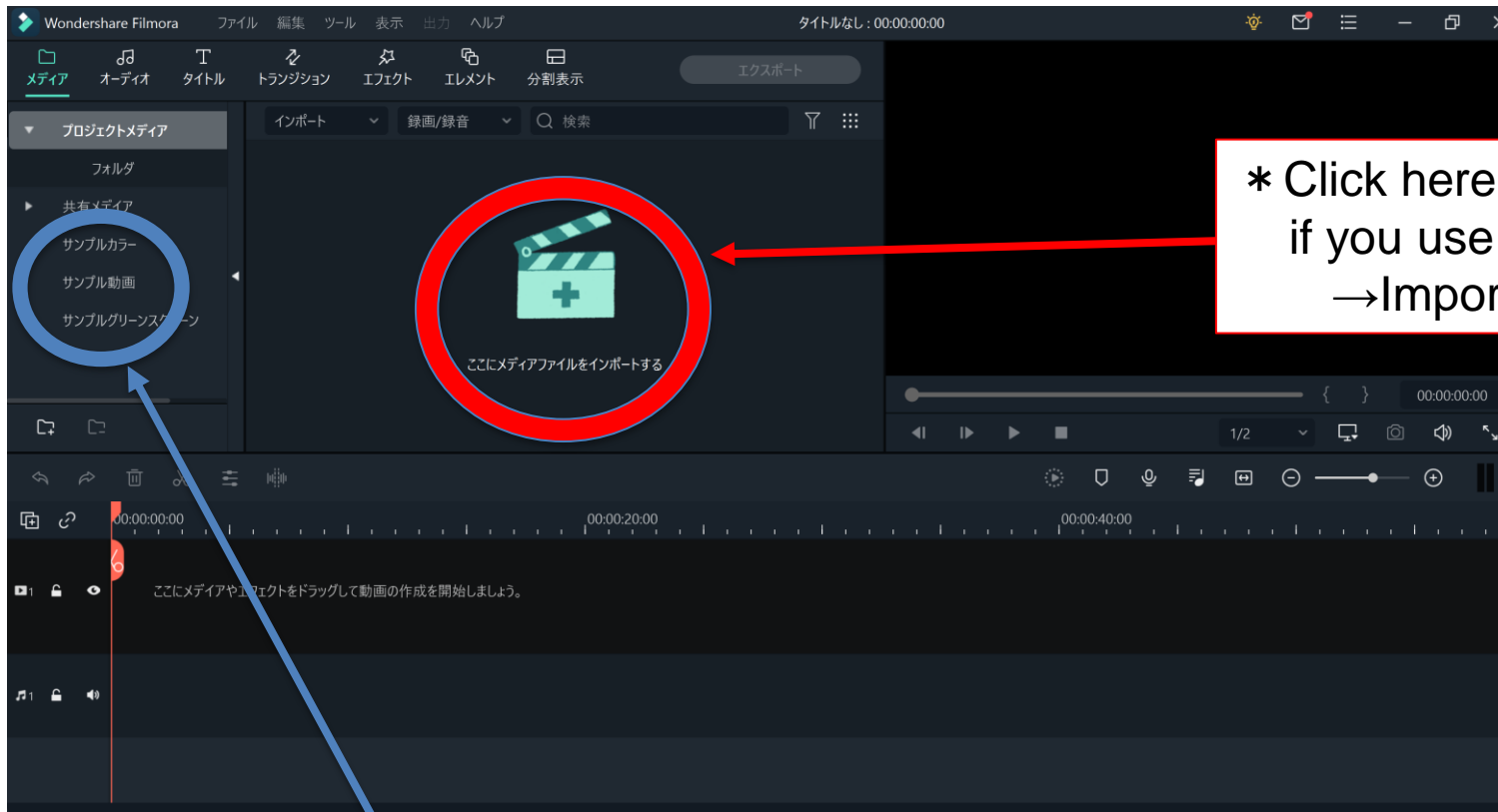


Cont'd: Language Setting



4. Click "OK"

Begin with a sample movie



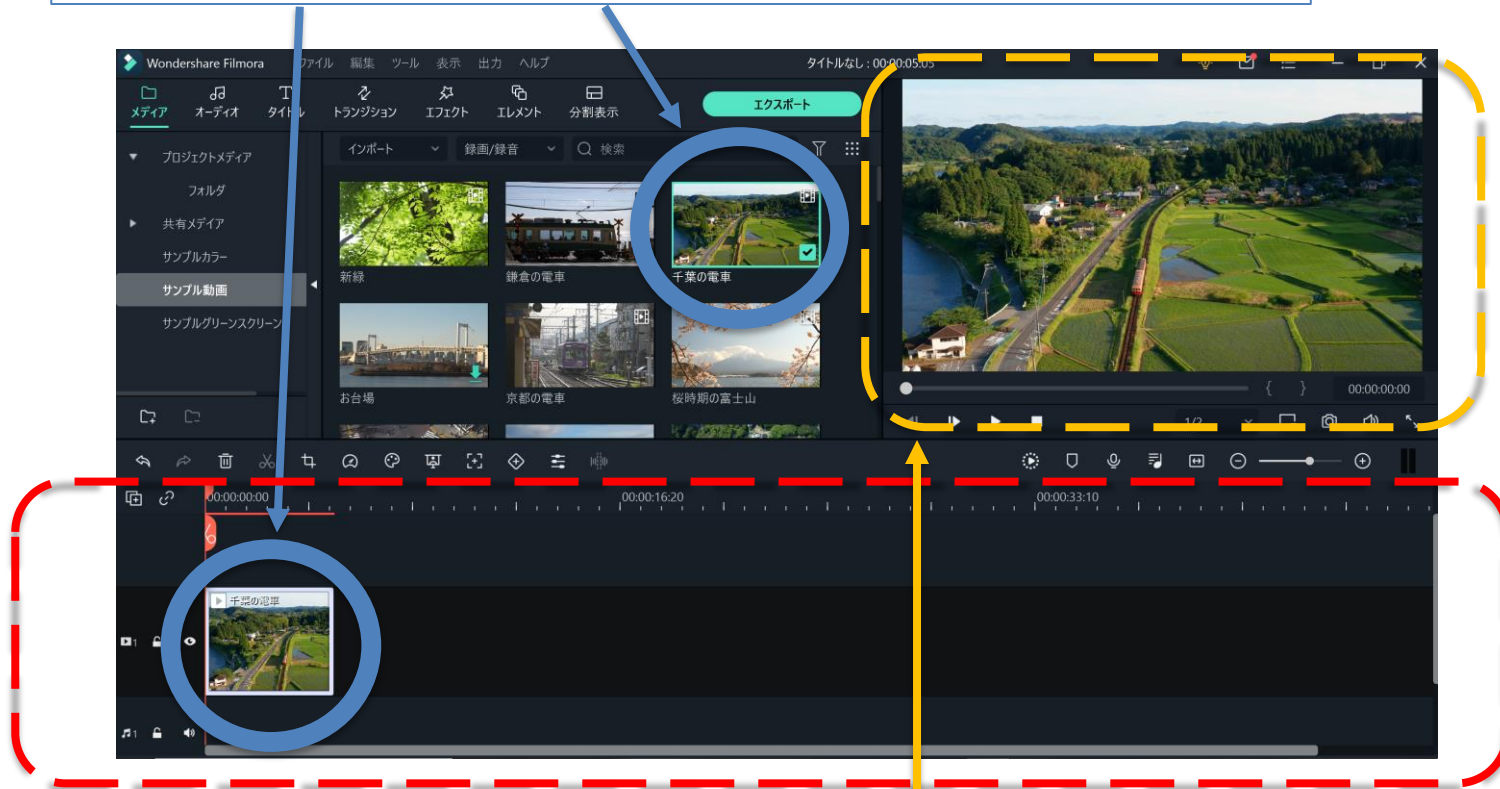
* Click here
if you use your videos
→ Import them

5. Click "Sample Video"

1st step for Editing: Import Videos



6. Click and drag a video to the low space of the screen



7. Low spaces = Editing space

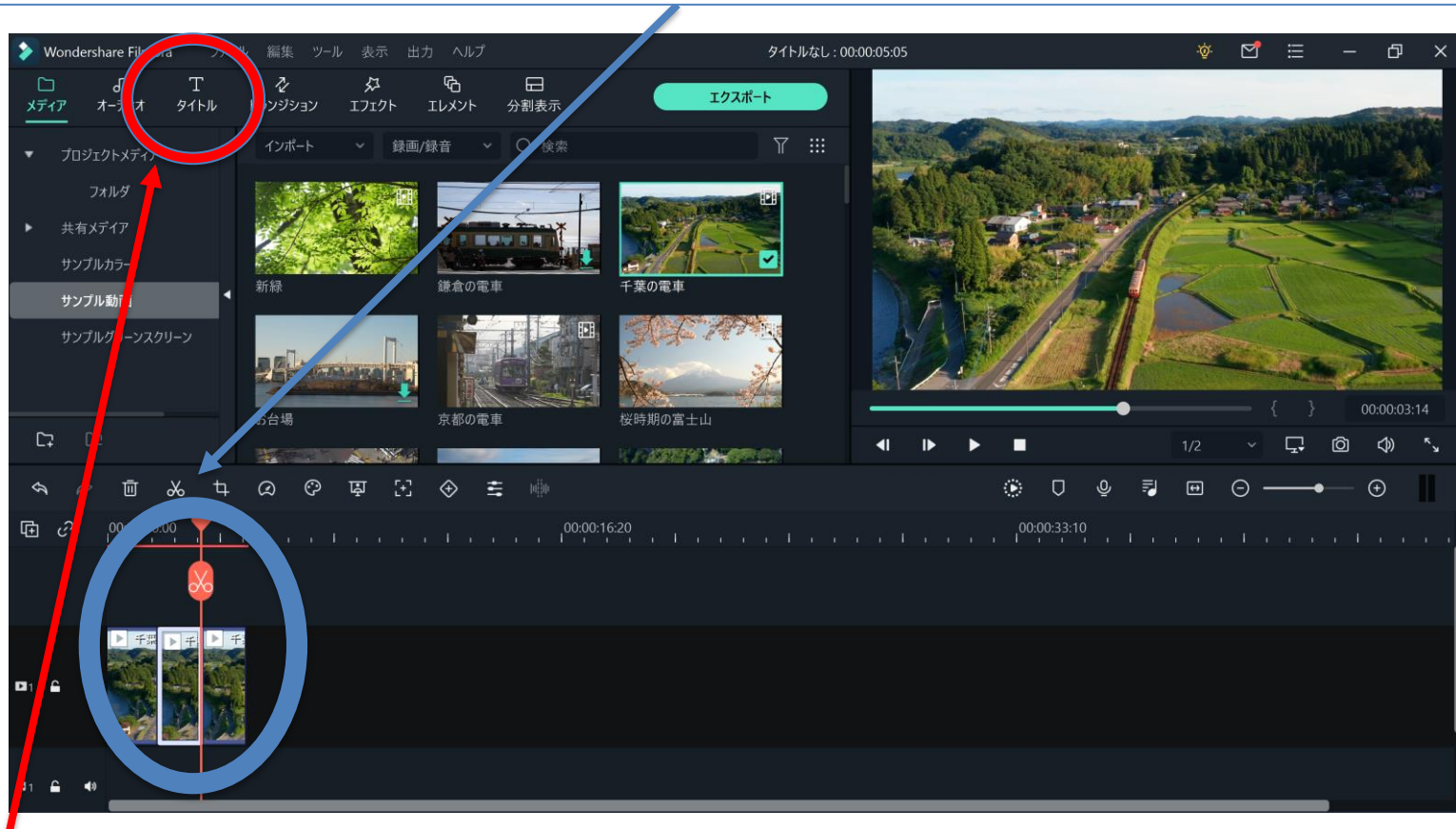
– You manipulate the dashed area!

8. Upper-right space = Check you current video

Removal of Unnecessary Scenes



9. Click the “scissors mark” → Split the video
→ Isolation of unnecessary scenes & Right-click and choose “delete”



10. Next step = Ways to insert your TEXT!
→ Begin with clicking “Titles”

How to Insert Your Texts

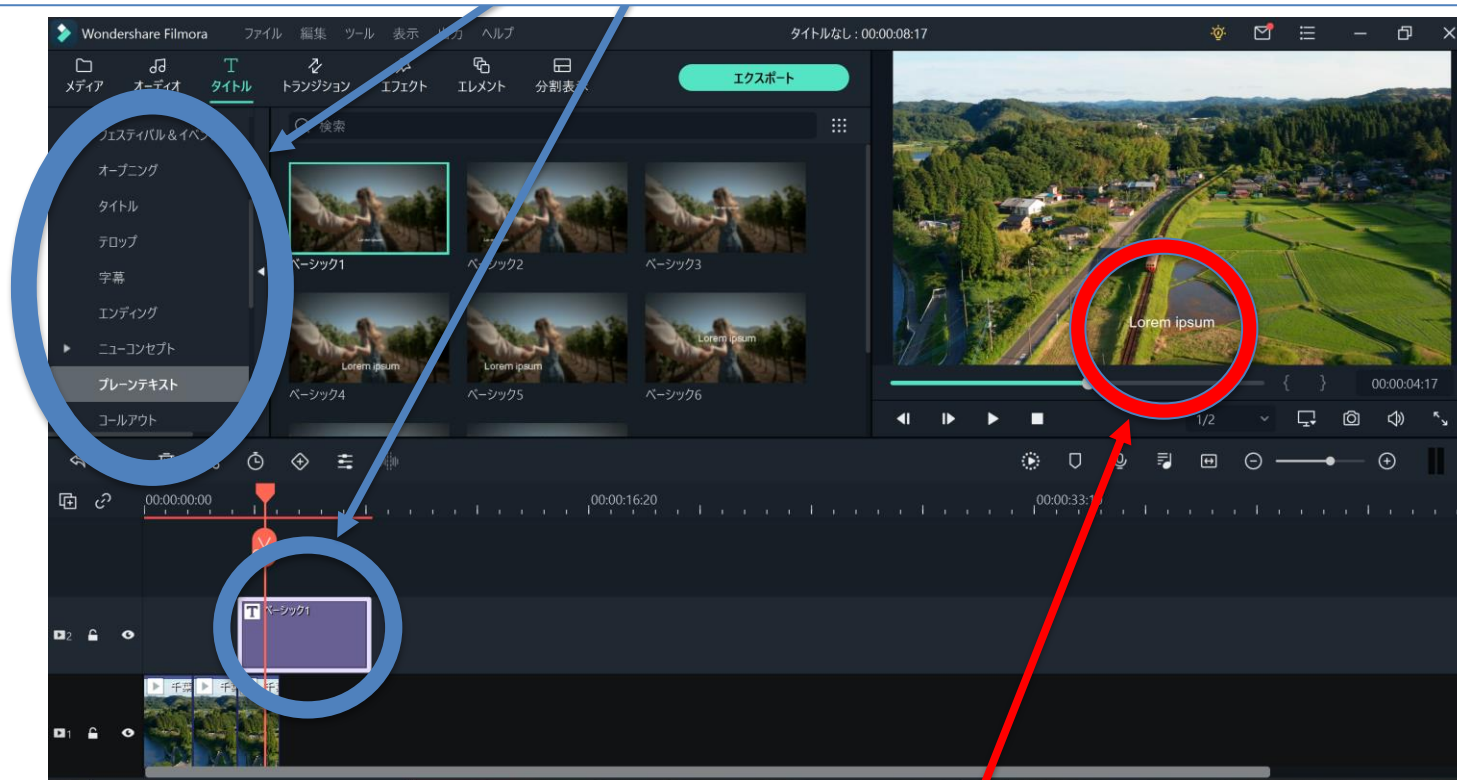


11. Choose a font from the left bar

→E.g. Click “Basic” & click and drag “Basic 1”

into any space a bit upper to the current video in the editing space

(Then, the second video layer shows up!)

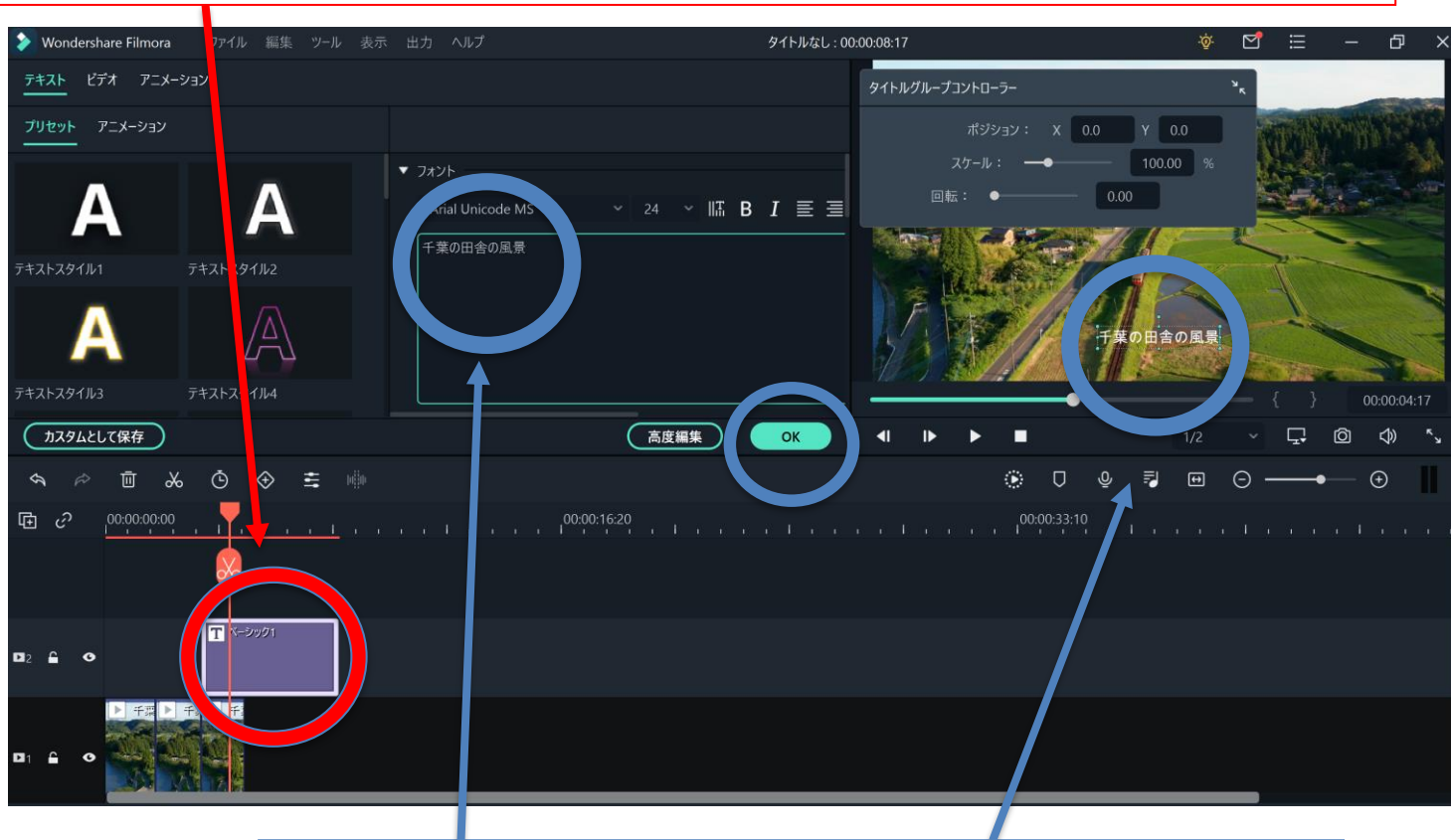


12. Default text appears here

→Edit the text as in the next slide

13. Double click the purple diagonal

→Text-editing screen displayed in the center upper area



14. Type your text you want to show in the video

→Confirm the text in the place you want to put

(End text editing by clicking “OK”)

Recommended Font → “Text style 2”

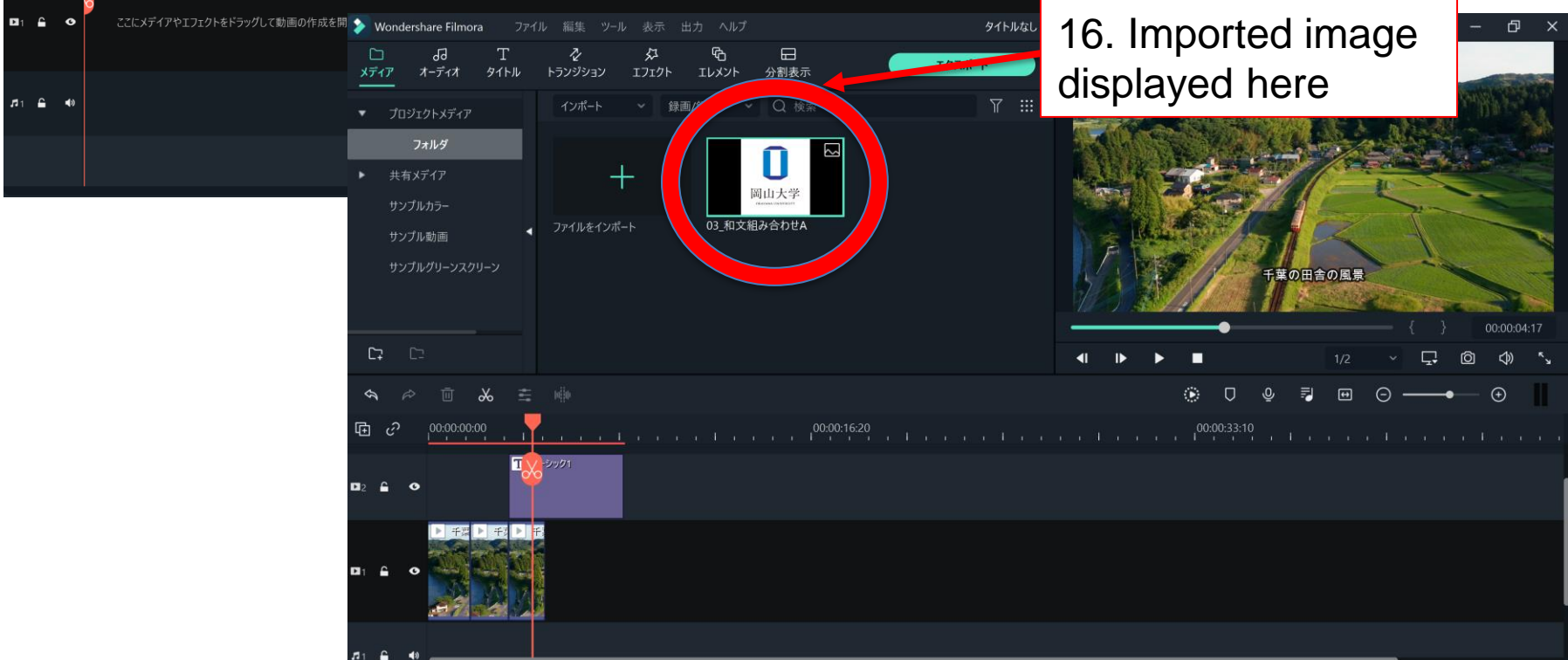

Insert Your Image Files

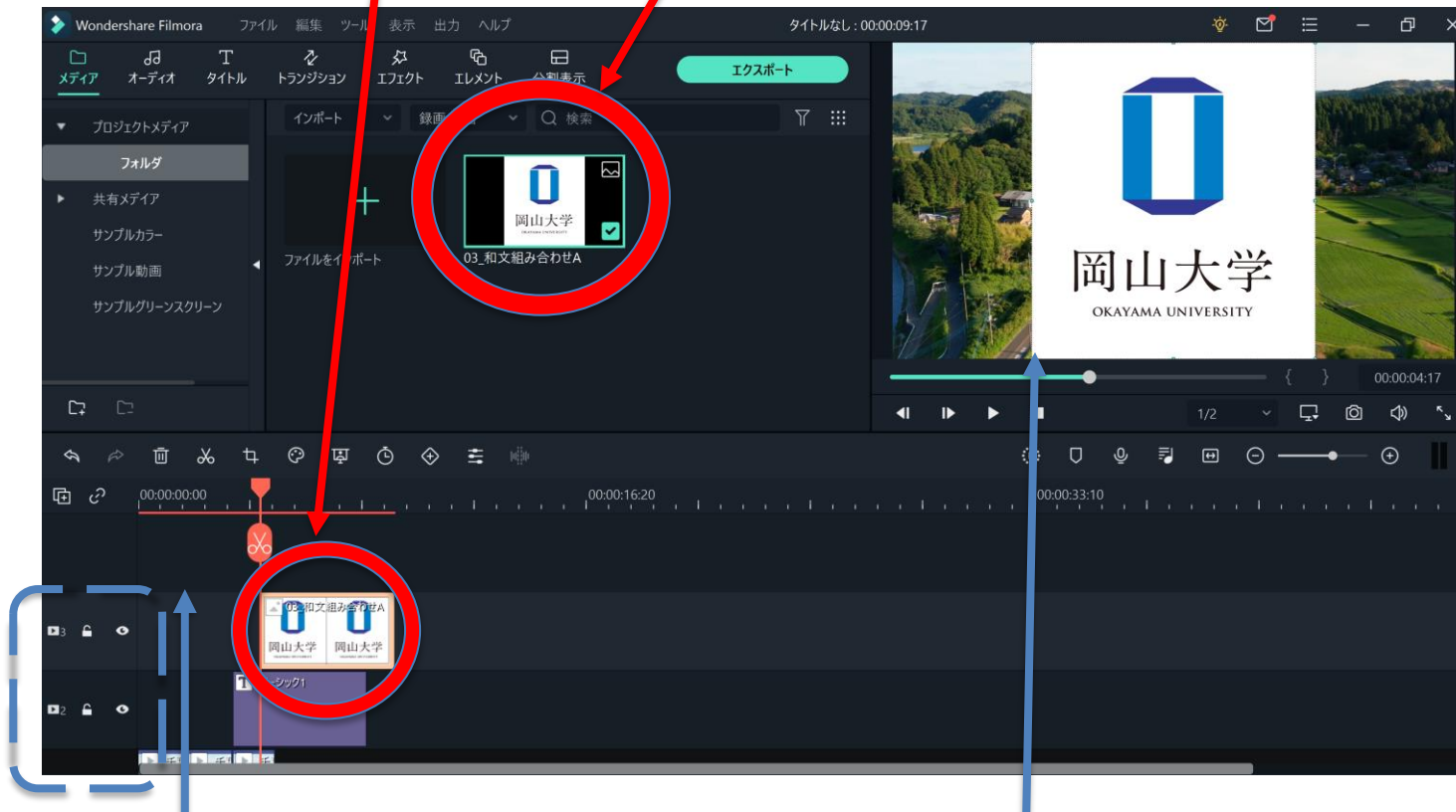


15. Click "Media"
→Click here
→Import your image file



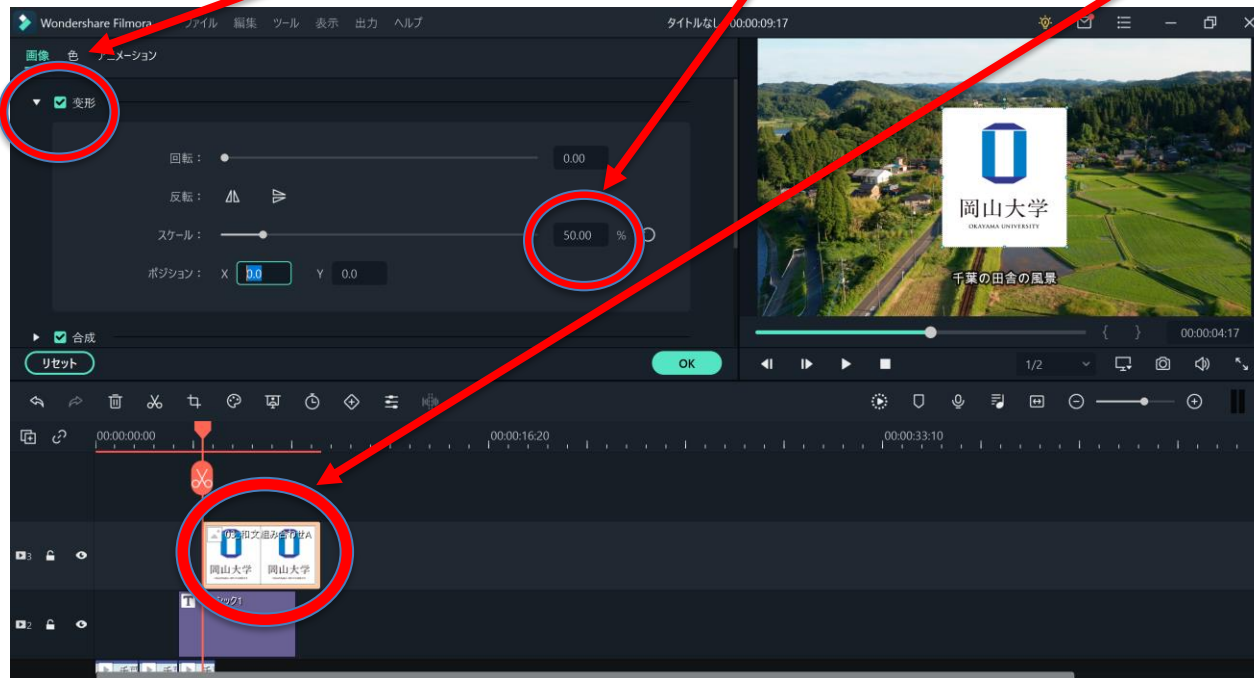
16. Imported image displayed here

17. Click and drag into the editing space



Contents in the upper layer are displayed foreground in the edited video

18. Double click the image
→Click “Transform”
→Change “Scale”

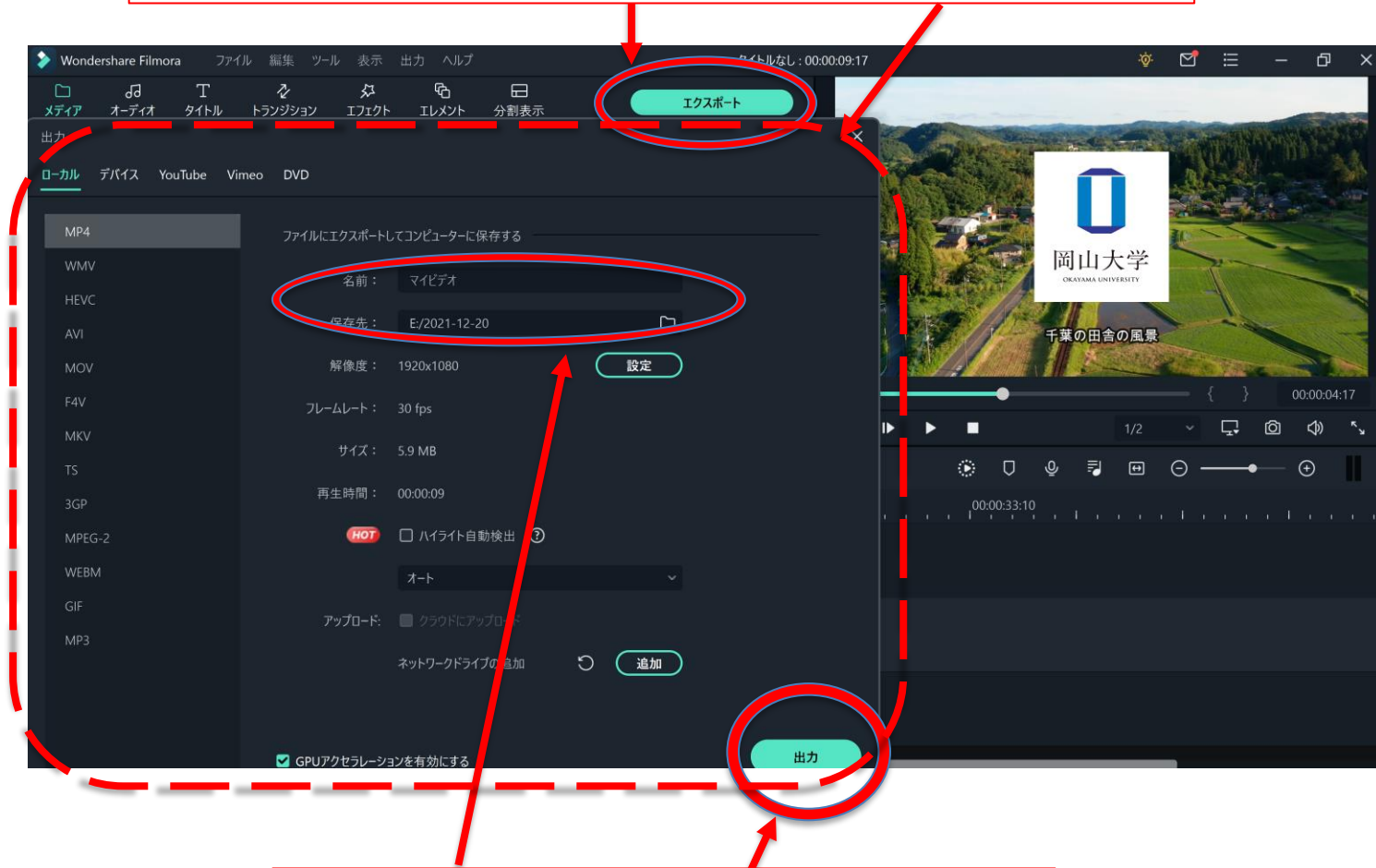


- In the upper-right screen, you can click and drag the image
→Images locate any places

Export Your Video (Need to create your ID)

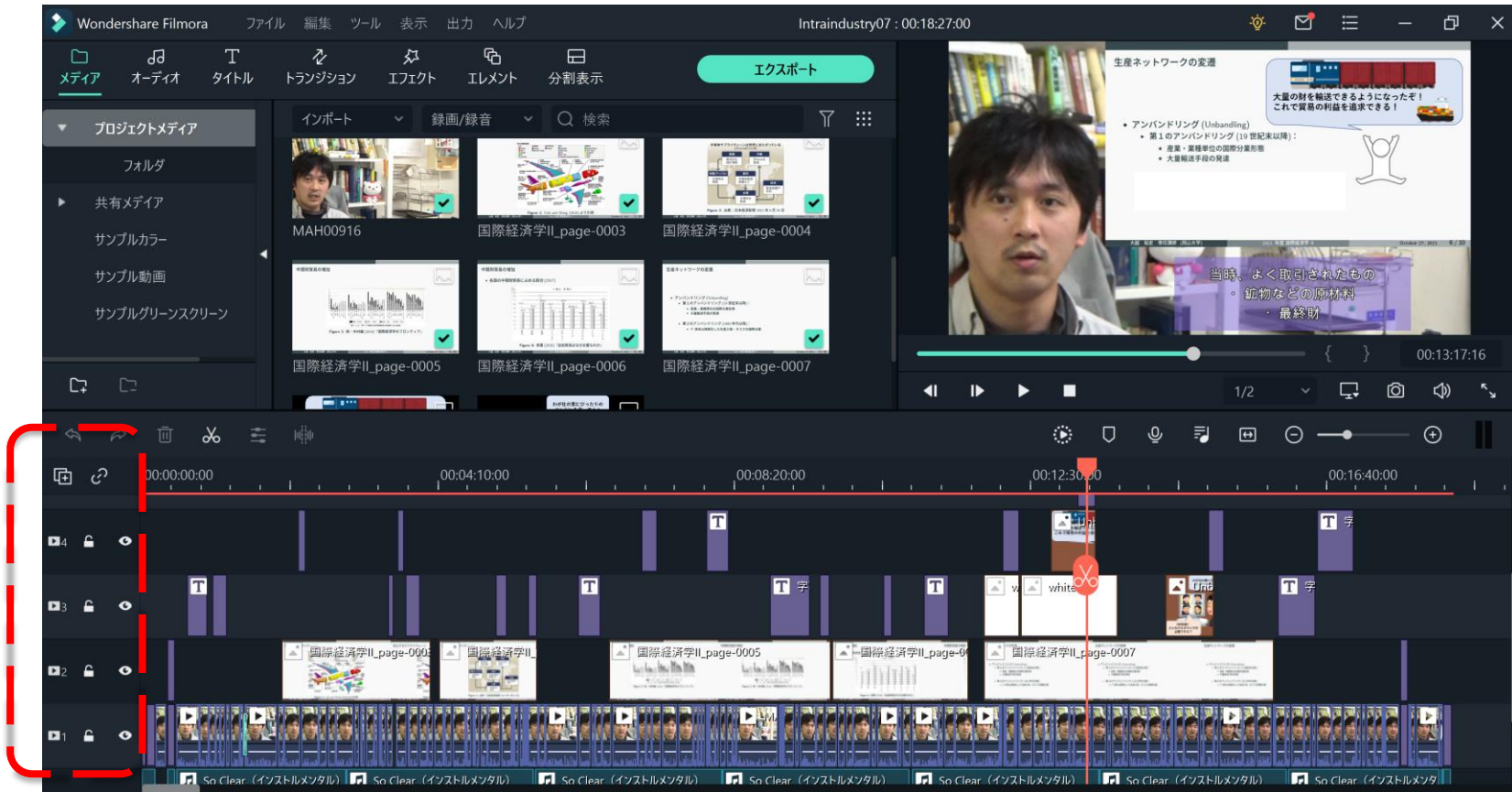


19. Click “Export” and login to your Wondershare ID
→New “Export” screen appears



20. Set “Name” and “Save to”
→Click “Export” at the lower-right

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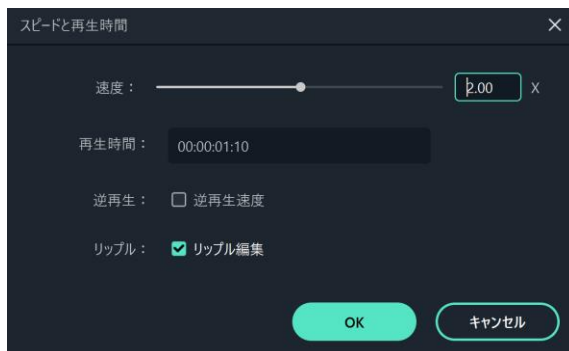
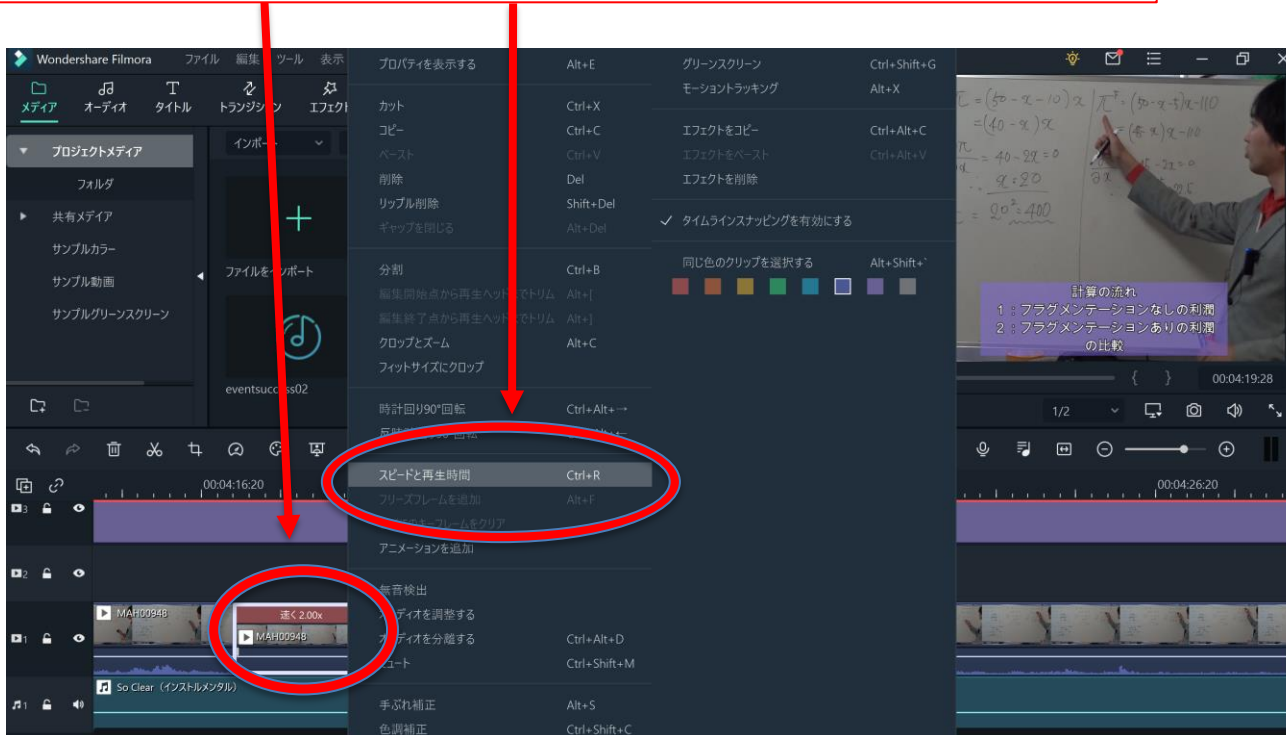
So Clear (インストルメンタル)

* Speed-up scenes in writings
You can see this in the next slide

Arrange the speed of scenes



* Right-click the scene you want to speed-up
→ Choose “Speed” → Click “Speed and duration”

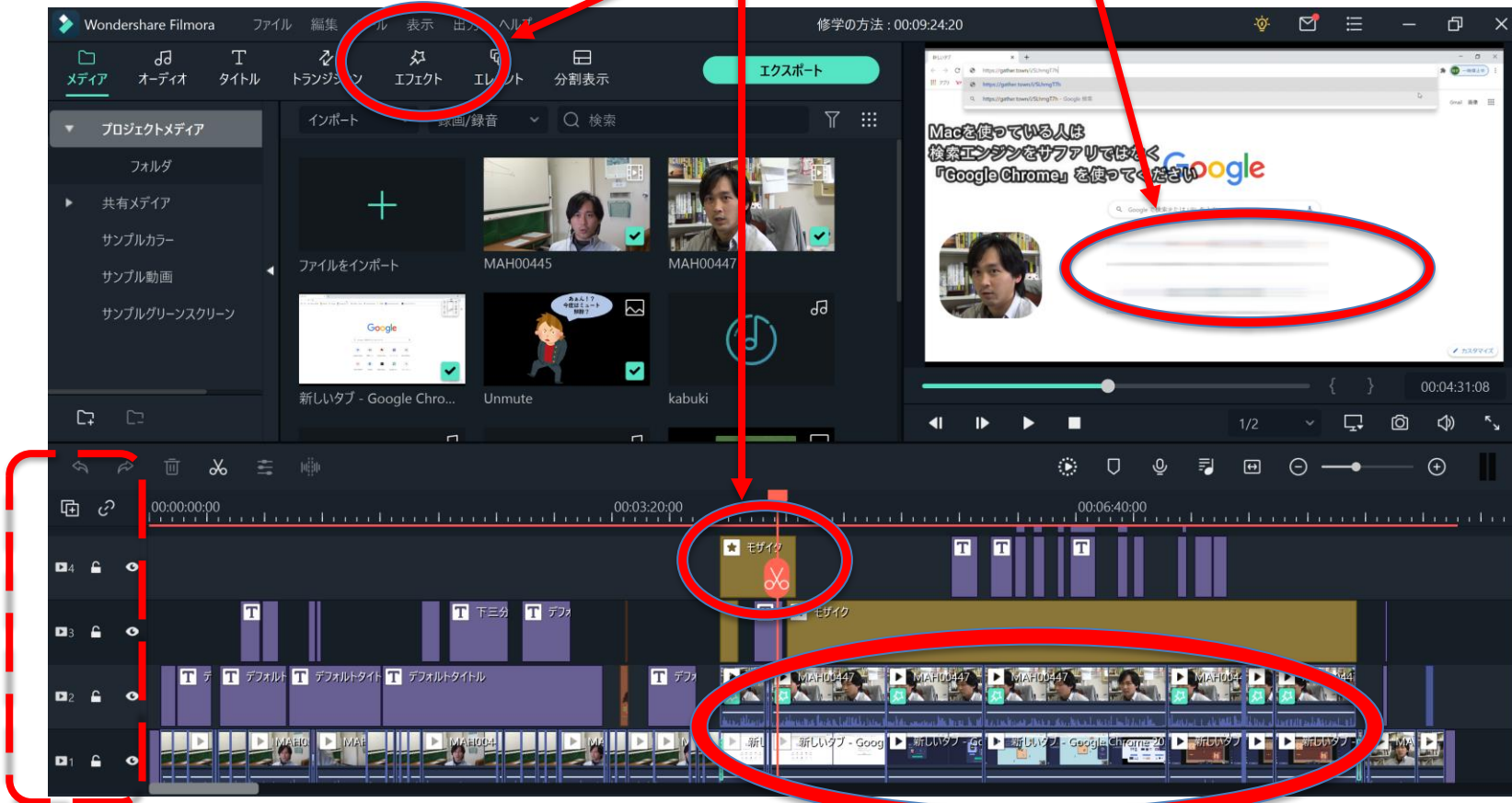


← “Custom Speed” display shows up,
and set the speed
「2.00」 = 「Double speed」

 - A few students gave me “good” via YouTube function

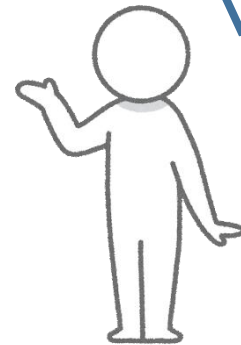
