岡山大学ベトナム留学生会とL-カフェはベトナム料理をワンコインで楽しむイベントを開催しました。学生は朝早くから料理を作り、100以上のバイン・ミー（有名なベトナム風のサンドイッチ）に加え、バイン・トロイ（甘いモチのようなデザート）や緑茶も売りました。
